Corporate Apprenticeship Program Expression of Interest (EI18-007)

The City of Regina is currently accepting applications from City employees for apprenticeship. Over the course of the next year we may have apprenticeship opportunities in the following trades:

Heavy Duty Mechanic

- Inspections, maintenance, overhaul, and servicing of all type of trucks and specialized bodies, and other associated equipment, or
- Maintenance and overhaul of bus engines, transmissions, differentials, brakes, suspensions, steering, air conditioning and all auxiliary equipment, including electrical components.

Electrical (Note: Instrumentation will be considered for existing electricians)

- Diagnose, test, repair, alter, construct, install and maintain electrical, control, lighting, security and sound systems in City facilities; or
- Electrical repairs and installations and the operation of equipment relating to the construction, maintenance and preservation of traffic signal and expressway lighting systems in Traffic Engineering.

Industrial Mechanic

- Install, trouble shoot, maintenance, repair and test mechanical equipment and machinery, systems and/or facilities.

Carpentry

- Carpentry duties related to a variety of City of Regina facilities including buildings, structures, furniture and equipment.

Welding

- Weld, braze, solder, cut and fabrication duties related to the maintenance and repair of all City of Regina fleet vehicles and equipment.

Plumber/Gas Fitter

- Diagnose, repair, alter, construct and maintenance of the plumbing, heating ventilation and air conditioning systems in City facilities.
